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1 What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. They enable the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) for a certain period of time, so you don't have to re-enter them each time you visit the site or browse its pages. 3 What type of cookies do we use?

Our Platform uses persistent and session cookies.

- *Session cookies*: are erased after the end of your browsing on our Platform or/ and after the closing of your web browser.
- *Persistent cookies*: remain in your computer or in your device, either till the time you decide to erase them or for a preset time.

3.1 Categories and purpose of Cookies used in our Platform

3.1.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Platform to function and cannot be switched off. These cookies help make our Platform usable and secure by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the Platform. Your consent is not required for the use of these cookies.

These cookies do not store, as a rule, any personally identifiable information about you. However, due to the technical nature of cookies, the possibility for a cookie to process your IP address, for it to function properly, cannot be excluded.

You may find a list of the necessary cookies, that our Platform uses, below:

Cookie Name	Purpose	Retention period	Provider (first party/third party)
csrftoken	Protects the platform and the user against Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) attacks. It ensures that forms and requests are intentionally submitted by the actual user and not a malicious third-party script.	1 year	First party
sessionid	Maintains the user's active session state. This is required to identify the user's specific session on the server, allowing them to log in and stay authenticated as they navigate between different pages of the platform.	End of session	First party

3.1.2 Third Party Platform Cookies

When using our Platform, you may be directed to other websites for such activities as viewing content hosted on those sites. These websites may use their own cookies. We do not have control over the placement of cookies by other websites you visit, even if you are directed to them from our Platform.

4 How to control and delete cookies

4.1 Cookie Tool/Banner

Our Platform's Cookie Tool/Banner can be utilized to customize your cookie preferences. During your first visit to our Platform, the tool will record if you have consented to the use of specific cookie categories and will ask for consent again, in preset time periods, to ensure users stay up to date with changes to our cookie and privacy policies (if applicable). If applicable, you may choose to provide your consent to the use of Statistical/Analytics, Advertising/Marketing, and Preferences Cookies through the Cookie Tool. Strictly necessary cookies cannot be disabled and do not require your consent to be used.

You can access the Cookie tool anytime by clicking the relevant icon located on the bottom of the webpage.

4.2 Using your Browser

Many of the cookies used on our Platform and through emails can also be disabled by disabling the cookies through your browser. To disable cookies through your browser, follow the instructions usually located within the "Help," "Tools" or "Edit" menus in your browser. Please note that disabling a cookie or category of cookies does not delete the cookie from your browser unless manually completed through your browser function.

Also, all web browsers allow you to manage cookies in order to either delete them once you finish visiting the website or set your preferences regarding cookie usage before you start browsing the website. Please note that deleting or rejecting cookies may negatively affect your browsing experience (e.g., some features may not be fully available).
